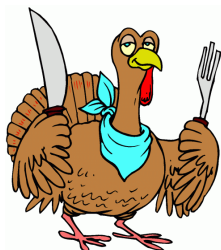
We are still looking for someone to coordinate a youth program for the middle and high school. If you are interested please contact the parish office. What a wonderful opportunity to share your faith.
