

On January 2nd, we celebrate the feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord a time when we recall the visit of the Three Wise Men. There is an old tradition of blessing your home on this day. The blessing has biblical roots tied to the Passover (Exodus 12:1-13). It takes place on the Epiphany marking the visitation of the Magi to the Christ Child and the revelation that Jesus is the son of God. If you wish to do this blessing, directions are in the back of the church and blessed chalk will be available after Mass on January 2nd or you may pick it up in the office.
