Celebrating Corpus Christi Feast June 11th

The feast of Corpus Christi is a celebration of Christ's presence in the Eucharist. It parallels the celebration on Holy Thursday when this sacrament was instituted. When the Eucharist is

carried in a solemn procession, it is an outward sign of Christian people giving public witness of their faith and devotion toward the Sacrament of Holy Eucharist. The Blessed Sacrament displayed in the Monstrance carried by the Priest is at the front of the procession under a canopy/baldachin. The canopy adds dignity to the procession by making a sacred space for the Eucharist. It is reminiscent of the tent of the Lord's presence where God dwelt with the Israelites in the wilderness.
