Religious Education

As Catholic parents it is your responsibility to teach your children about the Catholic faith. To assist you in this we offer religious education classes on Sundays after the 9:30am Mass, however we cannot do these classes without your help. **We need your help!!!!** Thank you to those who have stepped up to take this task on however we need more volunteers. Welcome to the Religious Education Classes beginning October 15th after the 9:30am Mass. It is important that your youth participate in the religious education classes as they are the future of our church.

- There will be a First Communion class for 2nd grade or above.
- 5th and 6th grade will begin preparing for Confirmation as the diocese asks that all children be Confirmed by the time they complete 6th grade. The Diocese requires 2 years of RE classes prior to Confirmation so preparation for 2025 Confirmation begins this school year.
- More volunteers are needed please step up to ensure our youth have the opportunity to learn about their faith and what it means to be a Catholic.
- You are encouraged to pray as a family by taking some time to sit down together and say a prayer and talk to your children about their faith.



Our Lady of Fatima appeared to three shepherd children between May and October of 1917. Each time Our Lady appeared she asked that we pray the rosary daily for "World Peace". On October 13, 1917, 70,000 people witnessed the "Miracle of the Sun" an

event so spectacular that it brought many to their knees. To remind people of Our Lady's message "America Needs Fatima" requests that we gather together in a public place to recite the rosary at a time near the 13th of October. On Saturday October 14th St. Francis de Sales held a Rosary Rally on the front steps of the rectory to pray for world peace. How appropriate that we prayed the rosary the same day there was an eclipse of the sun where it showed the sun as a ring of fire.
