## Epiphany House Blessing with Chalk

This Blessing is a centuries old tradition that you as a family can do on the feast of the

Epiphany. The blessing has biblical roots tied to the Passover in the book of Exodus: 12:1-13. It takes place on the Epiphany marking the visitation of the Magi to the Christ Child and the revelation that Jesus is the son of God. This traditional home blessing will serve as a symbol of hope and a visible reminder of faith and will be a strong reminder of how important God is to us and what an important factor Jesus is in our daily lives.

Why chalk? Chalk is an ordinary substance of the earth, "dust" and reminds us we are dust of the earth. Blessed chalk and instructions for Blessing the Home will be available at the office and on Sunday, January 7<sup>th</sup> as you leave the church.

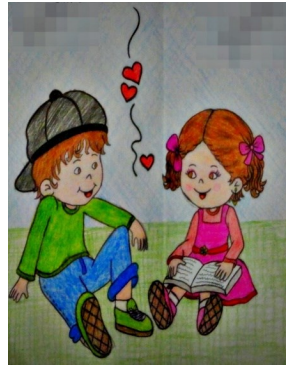

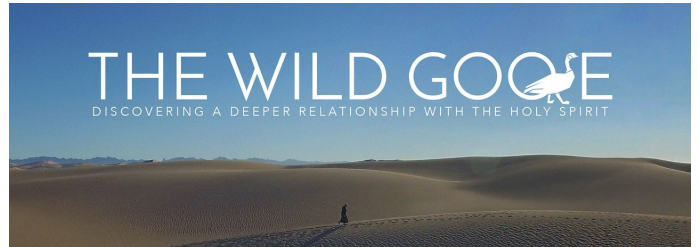
