This Sunday the 12<sup>th</sup> of January we celebrate the baptism of the Lord. The gospel of John (1:29-32) "**Behold the Lamb of God**", John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world! This is he of whom I said, "After me comes a man who ranks before me, because

he was before me." I myself did not know him, but for this purpose I came baptizing with water, that he might be revealed to Israel. (John 1:34) "And I have seen and have borne witness that this is the Son of God."

At his baptism "the heavens were opened" – the heavens that Adam's sin had closed – and the waters were sanctified by the descent of Jesus and the Spirit, a prelude to the new creation.
