Carlo Actuis

Father Taylor Reynolds of the Diocese of Alexandria LA stated **"A millennial being canonized is showing now that this path of Holiness is not foreign to our time."**

Carlo Actuis will become the first Millennial saint. He was born May 3, 1991 and died On October 12, 2006 at the age of 15.

From an early age Carlo had a great devotion to the Holy Eucharist and at eleven years he began cataloguing the Eucharist miracles from around the world. Carlo took great care in looking after others especially his peers. He defended disabled peers who were bullied and did voluntary work with homeless and destitute.

When he developed Leukemia, he offered up his suffering for Pope Benedict XVI and the Catholic church: "I offer to the Lord the sufferings that I will have to undergo for the Pope and for the Church." When he neared the end of his life, his pain became more intense he told his doctors: "there are people who suffer much more than me". He left this world on October 10, 2006. Carlo was to be canonized April 2025, however it was delayed due to the death of Pope Francis. He will be canonized on September 7th along with Pier Giorgio Frassati.

Pier Giorgio Frassati, April 6, 1901 to 4 July 1925. He was an Italian Catholic activist and a member of the Third Order of Saint Dominic. His father Alfredo was an agnostic who was active in national politics and was later the Italian ambassador to Germany. His mother was an artist who had great compassion for the poor. Pier shared his mother's compassion for the poor and often said: "Charity is not enough; we need social reform." At an early age he began helping the poor. On one occasion he answered the door to find a mother with her shoeless son begging for help. Pier's response was to take off his shoes and give them to the son who was shoeless. He became a mining engineer in order to "serve Christ better among the miners". He was an active mountaineer and athlete and at the age of 24 he contracted Polio and passed away shortly thereafter. At his funeral the streets were lined with thousands of mourners out of the reverence the people held for him. He was beatified by John Paul II on May 20 1990 and the Pope dubbed him the "Man of the Eight Beatitudes". Pier Giorgio Frassati will be canonized with Carlo Actuis on September 7, 2025.
