THE BEATITUDES

In Matthew's gospel chapter 5, Jesus begins the Sermon on the Mount teaching us how to find true happiness with God's help. He gave us eight blessing called the "Beatitudes".

- **Blessed are the Poor in Spirit; for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.**
Poor in spirit mean being humble and knowing we need God for everything. Those who are poor in spirit know they need God and as a result readily open themselves up to him.
- **Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.**
Jesus promises that those who turn to God when they are heartbroken will receive comfort. Sometimes God's comfort comes from other people. He assures us that he sees our sorrow and will comfort us.
- **Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.**
The word meek means gentle, patient, and no insisting on your own way. It is about having strength under control-being calm and kind instead of angry or aggressive. They are patient with others because they know God has been patient with them.
- **Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.**
Hunger and thirst for righteousness, means they want to do what is right and to grow closer to God – as strongly as a hungry person wants food or a thirsty person wants water. God will satisfy that desire for goodness.
- **Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.**
Merciful people forgive others, are kind and compassionate and don't seek revenge when wronged. The Lords Prayer says "forgive us as we forgive those who trespass against us." If we forgive and love others, God will be merciful to us.
- **Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.**
A pure heart loves God above all and wants to do the right thing simply because it's right. God reveals Himself to those who are honest, humble, and holy of heart.
- **Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons' of God.**
Peacemakers are people who try to help resolve conflicts and encourage people to get along instead of fighting.
- **Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.**
Jesus says those who face persecution for doing what is right are blessed. (Matthew 5:12) Any suffering we endure for God is not for nothing – it will be repaid with eternal joy in His Kingdom.
