RE Classes have begun, if you haven't registered your child yet, please do so. Classes meet following Sunday Mass.

First grade will begin the process of getting ready for receiving the sacraments they will receive next year as 2nd graders.

The 2nd grade class will continue the preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion. Reconciliation will be held in February (date to be determines).

First Communion will be May 10th.

We are still in need of a 3rd and 4th grade teacher!

If you have a candidate for Confirmation (5th and 6th grade) they must attend classes for this year 2025-2026 and 2026-2027. The diocese requires a **two-year preparation** prior to receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation! We are scheduled for 2027.

If you have a child preparing for any of the sacraments you will need to provide a copy of their baptismal certificate. The registration fee for RE is \$25.00 per child not to exceed \$75.00 per family.
