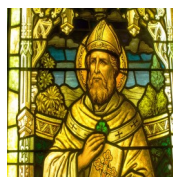

## **ST. PATRICK'S DAY, MARCH 17**



Time for wearing of the green to honor St. Patrick and the Emerald Isle and keep those mischievous leprechauns at bay. In the early 1900's Irish immigrants missing their homeland began celebrating their Irish heritage on St. Patrick's feast day. Over the years this has grown to where even if you aren't Irish you celebrate their heritage on March 17<sup>th</sup>.

Although Patrick was never formally canonized by a pope he is listed as a Saint and is the patron saint of Ireland. Legend has it that he drove all snakes from Ireland, it is said he used the shamrock as an illustrative parable to teach three persons in one God and during his evangelizing journey he carried an ash wood walking stick. He would thrust it into the ground wherever he was preaching it is said that his message took so long that the stick had taken root by the time he finished.
