Reflection from Franciscan Media: This is the "feast of grandparents". But the feast has a message for the younger generation as well. It reminds the young that older people's greater perspective, depth of experience, and appreciation of life's profound rhythms are all part of a wisdom not to be taken lightly or ignored.

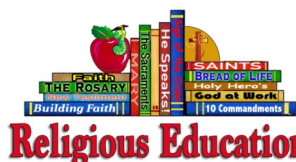

# Religious Education



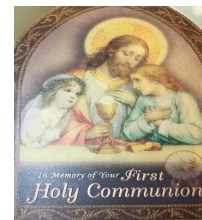
*Time to prepare for Religious Education!!* **If you still need to register your child for RE**

**classes**, please call or come into the parish office to fill out a registration form. If you are unable to come into the parish office, please e-mail Lauren at [lauren.seymour@sfdsc.org](mailto:lauren.seymour@sfdsc.org) with the child's name, age, date of birth, the grade they will be in, what sacraments they have received, and if they will be receiving a sacrament this year. Please also include the parents names, addresses and contact information.



**CONFIRMATION:** Time to register for Confirmation if you have a child that is 5<sup>th</sup> grade or above and has been baptized and received the sacrament of the Eucharist please register your child. If you are an adult who has not been confirmed and wish to receive the sacrament please contact the office. Confirmation is scheduled for April 10, 2023.

**FIRST COMMUNION:** Who can make their First Communion? Any child who is baptized and is 7 years (2<sup>nd</sup> grade) or older can receive the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. The sacrament of reconciliation is scheduled for March 16, 2023 and the Holy Eucharist is scheduled for May 21<sup>st</sup>.
