

# **Religious Education**

#### HOLY WEEK

Sunday April 13<sup>th</sup> is the beginning of Holy Week the most important week in Catholicism. This reflects the last 8 days of Jesus' life and His resurrection. Holy Week begins with Palm Sunday and ends with Easter Sunday. Here is what happens during Holy Week:

- Palm Sunday, Jesus triumphantly enters Jerusalem. (Matthew 21:1-10) On this day we receive a palm to remind us of how Jesus was received this day.
- Monday of Holy Week, Jesus Cleanses the Temple (Mark 11:15-18) (Matthew 21:12-13)
- Tuesday of Holy Week Mary Anoints Jesus at Bethany (John 12:3)
- Wednesday of Holy Week, called Spy Wednesday. Judas went to the High Priests to see how much they would pay him to betray Jesus, hence the name Spy Wednesday. (Mark 14:10-11)
- Holy Thursday also known as Mandy Thursday: Jesus celebrated the Last Supper and gave us the Eucharist; he then goes to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray and while there is arrested and taken away.
- Good Friday, Jesus is taken before Pilate and sentenced to be crucified. He is scourged, beaten, given a crown of thorns and crucified. (Mark 15: 1-39) Why do we call it Good Friday when Jesus suffered so much that day? Because the suffering and sacrifice Jesus made that day saved us from our sins. Isaiah in chapter 52 and 53 speaks of The Lord's Coming Salvation and He Was Pierced for Our Transgressions.
- Holy Saturday, Jesus is placed in his tomb. (Mark 15:42-67). On this day we celebrate the Easter Vigil Mass. This Mass begins after sundown with a bonfire outside the church, everyone lights candle and processes into the church filling it with light. This Mass has many readings of Jesus' death and Resurrection. At this Mass new catechumens (those coming into the church) will receive their Baptism, First Communion and or Confirmation.
- Easter Sunday, Jesus rises from the dead. (Mark 16:1-8).

Easter is not a one-day celebration but a season beginning Easter Sunday and ending on Pentecost Sunday. The whole world changed after Jesus's resurrection, it was a life changing event that we have been celebrating for over 2, 000 years.
