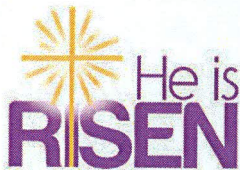

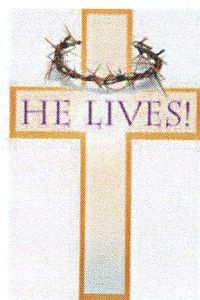


**Wishing all of you a very
