“40 CANS FOR LENT”

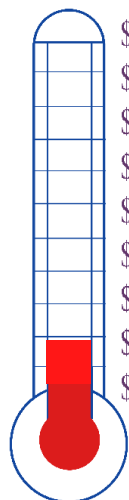
Knights of Columbus Food Drive
