Worthy District Deputies, Grand Knights & Financial Secretaries,

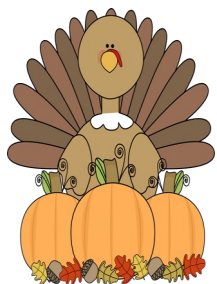

Got tickets?? We have approximately 20 left, better get them before they're gone, gone, GONE!

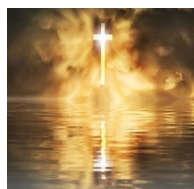
