## Religious Education



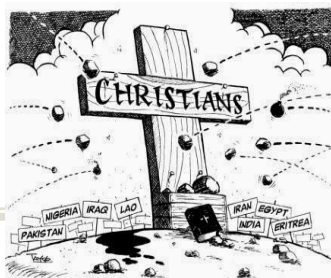
The youth group will start on December 2<sup>nd</sup> with a pizza party after the 4:00PM Mass. Come and join in.
